

# WELCOME TO THE 2019 ASICS Manchester Marathon

If you are feeling adventurous why not get out on the course to support all the runners? Don't forget your runners need support on the course, not just at the finish line. For ease of travel and due to road closures for the event, we recommend that spectators use the metrolink as the easiest way to travel around the course.

Based at Lancashire Cricket Ground for friends and family, the hangout will feature a stage and big screen where spectators can watch live coverage of the event. A DJ will be on set, along with a choir and prize giving. Our title partner ASICS will be in the area along with three different food stalls and a bar, making this a great spot to relax whilst waiting for friends and loved ones taking part in the event. Please note there is a strict capacity policy at this venue, and entry will be on a first come first served basis.





# Getting There Metrolink

- Metrolink is a great way to get to the race and show your support around the course. (12-minute frequency after 09:00am).
  There will be additional carriages on the trams on race day to provide extra capacity, particularly on the Altrincham line.
- The nearest stops to the start area are Pomona, Exchange Quay and Trafford Bar. The nearest stops to the finish line, the hangout, bga drop, and main toilets is Old Trafford. For more information please go to: https://www.greatermanchestermarathon.com/event-info/travel-and-parking/
- Metrolink offer a number of cost effective ticket options for both runners and spectators. Weekend adult travelcards are available for only £6.60 and this entitles you to for travel from 6.00pm Friday evening to end-of-service on Sunday evening. 1 day anytime travelcards are also available from £4.80. Download the getmethere app to buy your ticket up to a week in advance and avoid queues! If you're travelling with your family, it's just £9.20 for the whole weekend and covers up to two adults and three children\*. You must buy your ticket before you board. Both of these travelcards allow you to make an unlimited number of journeys across the whole network over the entire the weekend. It couldn't be easier to get to and from the race and support your runner right round the course all the way to the finish line!



For some good views of the race, you may want to alight at the following stops:

Sale	10.2km	Okm	09:26-11:06	The runners will pass directly in front of the Sale stop.
Brooklands	14.1km 25.7km	Okm	09:34-11:33 10:00-13:01	An excellent place to watch! The runners pass this point twice (14.1km & 25.7km)
Timperley	17km 23km	1km	09:41-12:01 09:53-12:42	Watch the runners as they pass through Timperley village (17km & 23km)
Altrincham	19km	Okm	09:45-12:28	The runners pass directly in front of this stop
Navigation Rd	18.7km 21.2km	0.6km	09:40-12:30	The runners will come along Stockport Road, which is 0.6km away from the tram stop and pass by at 18.7km and 21.2 km
