

### The A56 southbound will be closed:

- 04:00 13:00 Deansgate Interchange to White City Way
- 05:00 13:00 Deansgate Interchange to Edge Lane
- 08:30 16:30 Edge Lane to Ashfield Road (One lane open to access M60 from Green Street)

### The A56 northbound will be closed:

- 05:00 13:00 Barton Road to White City Circle
- 14:00 16:30 Barton Road to Kingsway
- 08:00 08:30 Harboro Way to Glebelands

### The A56 will be closed in both directions:

- 08:00 13:00 White City Circle to Deansgate Interchange
- 05:00 13:00 White City Circle to Kingsway
- 08:00 11:40 Deansgate Interchange to John Dalton Street
- 08:30 14:00 Barton Road to Stamford Brook Road

# **BEST ADVICE**

If you need to use the A56 southbound, use the outer diversion route, A5103 Princess Road (Princess Parkway) to avoid major disruption to your journey. If you need to access the city during the northbound closure, use A5181 Barton Road and then B5211 Barton Dock Road to the A57 and then follow signs for the city, alternatively after 14:00 when A56 north will be open. Use Barton Road and then Kingsway to re-join A56 into the City.

# M60 JUNCTION 7 08:00 - 16:30

There is no exit from the M60 at junction 7 in either direction.

Access on and onto the M60 at junction 7 will be restricted. The anticlockwise on slip will remain open for authorised motorway traffic from the Stretford Meadows Estate (For use ONLY by drivers who comply with Motorway driving regulations). Traffic travelling in both directions that wish to leave the M60 at junction 7 will need to leave at junction 6, 8 or junction 9 dependant on their destination or use the M66 to access areas around Altrincham.

# PARKING RESTRICTIONS

We would ask you not to park on the race route. There are parking restrictions in place between 23:00 on Saturday 4th April through to 18:00 on Sunday 5th April for the entire route. Vehicles parked on the route will be towed away.

# PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Roads closures will be in effect along the marathon route and those that are open will be very busy. Many bus services will also be diverted due to these closures.

We recommend using Metrolink to travel to and from the race as there are several stops close to the start and finish lines in Trafford.
