

# THERME MANCHESTER MARATHON & MANCHESTER HALF SUPPORTER GUIDE



**T**he 2021 Therme Manchester Marathon will be the biggest the city has ever seen, with almost 40,000 runners registered to run either 26.2 or 13.1 miles on Sunday 10th October.

We know not everybody will be able to come to Manchester in person this year, so this guide gives details of how best to follow the action from afar. We will be providing full coverage of both events, allowing supporters to follow the action from wherever they are in the world.

## **TIMING UPDATES**

The time at which each runner begins their challenge will differ, with starts spread out over several hours to enable a comfortable environment, and adequate space on the roads. Each runner is issued an allocated arrival and estimated start time in advance, which you can use as a guide to when they will begin.

On our website you will be able to find a link to our timing partners, allowing you to search for each runner individually. Their accurate progress will update as they cross each of the multiple timing mats on the course from the start line to the finish.
