NOTICE OF ROAD CLOSURES

ADIDAS MANCHESTER MARATHON, SUNDAY 19TH APRIL 2026

Please find below best advice on how to find information concerning road closure details for the forthcoming adidas Manchester Marathon specific to **TIMPERLEY**

The adidas Manchester Marathon will travel via Park Road towards Timperley, before taking Stockport Road to complete a loop of Altrincham centre, before returning via Stockport Road, Shaftesbury Avenue and Thorley Lane, before the race continues to proceed north along Brooklands Road. This route is chosen for the safety of competitors and to facilitate the large number of participants taking part in the event. Consultation occurs with many authorities including Greater Manchester Police, TfGM, and Trafford Council. Emergency services vehicles attending a call have unrestricted access at all times. If you have additional care needs please ensure your care agency has contacted us. They need to get in touch via the email address roadclosures@aso-uk.com as soon as possible.

Road opening times are governed not only by the competitors, but also after they have passed through by safety measures in place to protect our workforce removing traffic management controls, and for our teams clearing the roads of infrastructure and litter after the event. Aside from the times outlined there is no vehicle movement or vehicle crossing available at all other times. Drivers using closed roads without

authorisation are liable to Police action.

ROADS WILL BE CLOSED IN THE AREAS BELOW FROM 8:30AM-5.30PM (EXCEPT TIMPERLEY CROSSROADS THAT IS CLOSED FROM 7AM).

Residents on Stockport Road - between Timperley crossroads and Shaftesbury Ave (Hare & Hounds pub), or on roads which exit onto Stockport Road.

Residents can leave using the Stockport Road in the direction of the Hare and Hounds until 8.30am, when the main road closes. They can also use Grove Lane which will give them access to the A56 or the crossover between Moss Lane and Wood Lane up until 9.30am, and then again from 3.15pm. Residents **MUST** drive slowly as they will be driving on a closed road.

Residents on Shaftesbury Avenue.


Residents should park their cars on the south side service road. Doing so will mean that they will be able to leave all day via Seymour Grove onto Wood Lane.

Residents on Stockport Road - between Timperley crossroads and Brooklands roundabout.

Residents can leave but **MUST** use Aimson Road West to access Thorley Lane up until 9.30am and then again from 3.15pm. Residents **MUST** drive slowly as they will be driving on a closed road.

Residents on Thorley Lane, or on roads which exit onto Thorley Lane.

Residents can leave using Thorley Lane, but only in the direction of Shaftesbury Avenue up until 9.30am, and then again from 3.15pm (subject to the last participant having passed). Residents **MUST** drive slowly as they will be driving on a closed road.



Vehicle Crossing Point on Stockport Road Junction with Moss Lane & Wood Lane

This vehicle crossing point will be operational only between the following times: 8.30am - 9.30am and then again from: 3.15pm - 5.30pm

Between 9:30am - 3:15pm this vehicle crossing point is closed and no vehicle crossing is available

PLEASE NOTE:

Parking is suspended along the race route from 11.00pm on Saturday 18th April through to when the roads re-open. Cars parked on the route will be towed.

Whilst we will do our best there is a small chance that the times stated could change in advance, or on the day.

In some unavoidable circumstances access/egress may be slightly delayed or shorter than stated. In this unlikely instance we will do our best to communicate delays through the stewards at locations.
