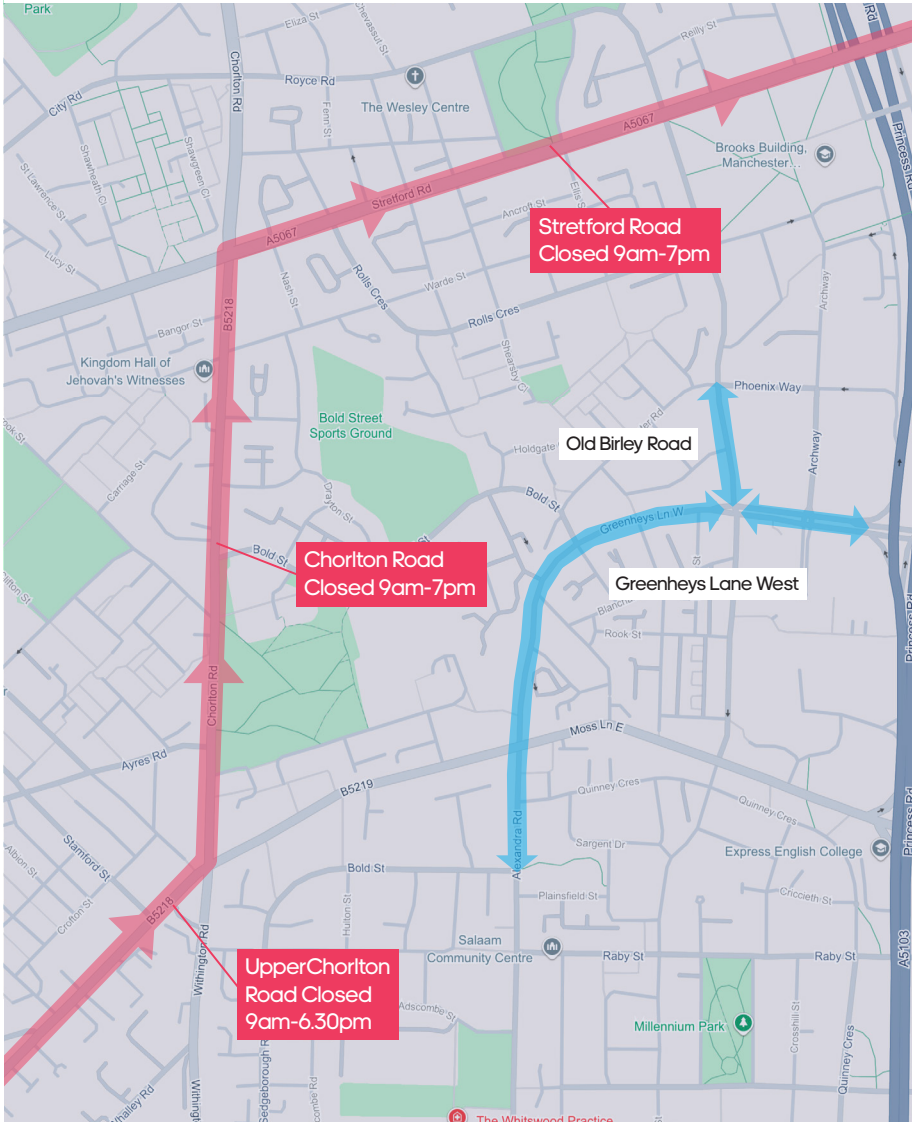
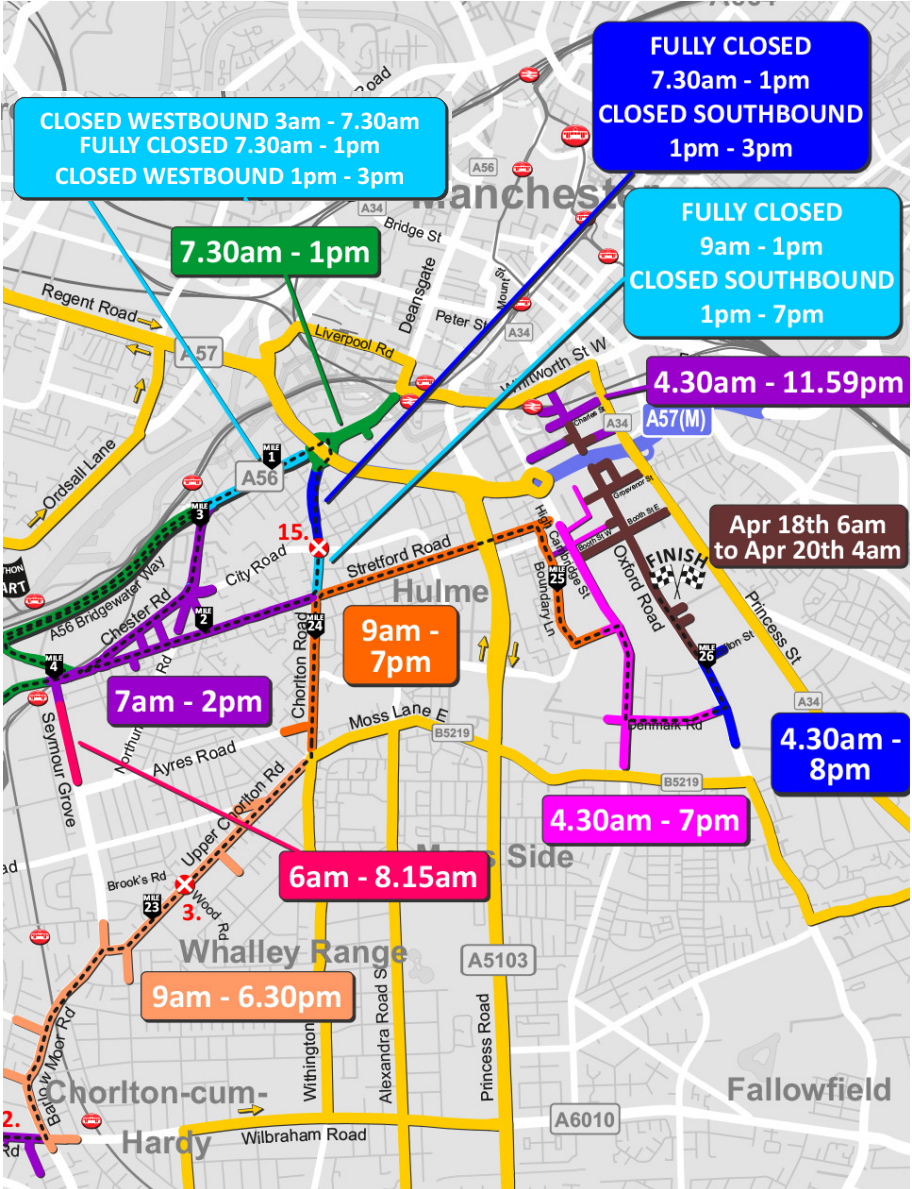


For residents in the area bounded by

The 2026 adidas Manchester Marathon will see 40,000 participants take to the streets of Manchester & Trafford this April following a similar route to 2025, returning to the exciting finish on Oxford Road.

After leaving Chorlton and turning on to Upper Chorlton/Chorlton Road at approx. mile 23, participants will take a right turn onto Stretford Road, then

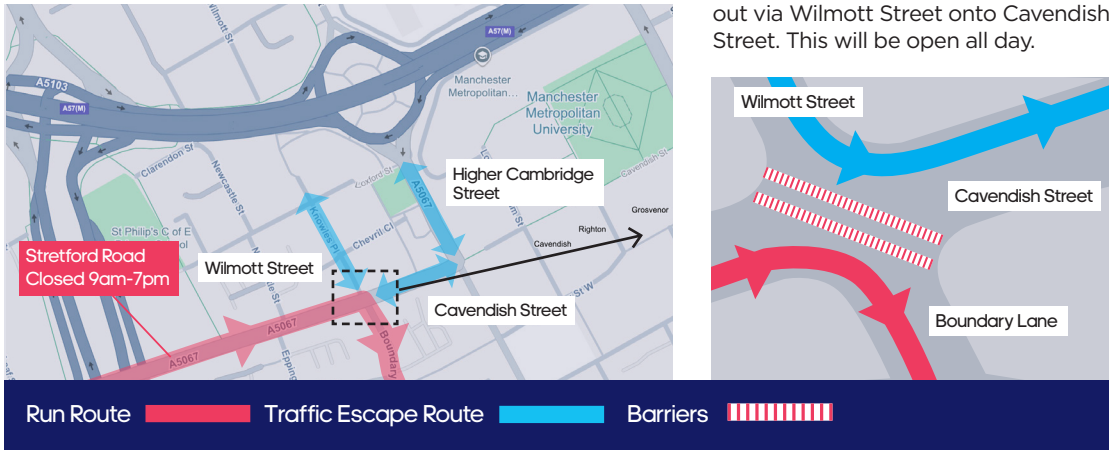
right onto Boundary Lane, then Burlington St, Lloyd St N, Denmark Road, before a left turn onto the finish straight on Oxford Road.

You are receiving this leaflet in addition to the standard road closure leaflet already delivered. To reduce the impact on local residents in the area this leaflet illustrates possible vehicle routes for specific areas adjacent to the route

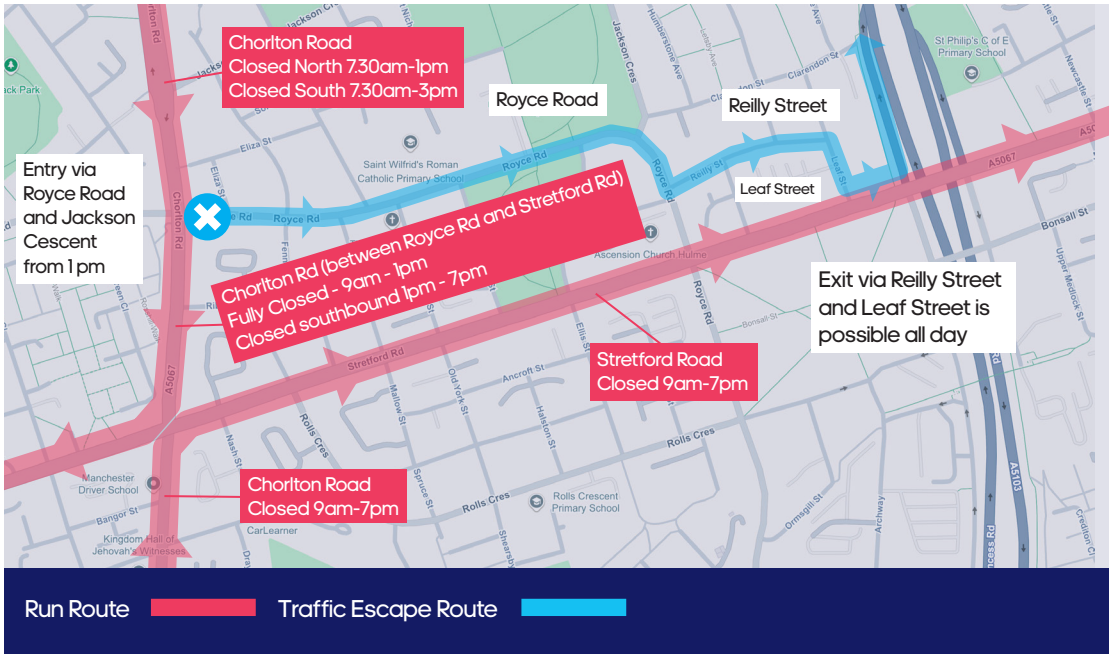

For residents in the Loxford estate area



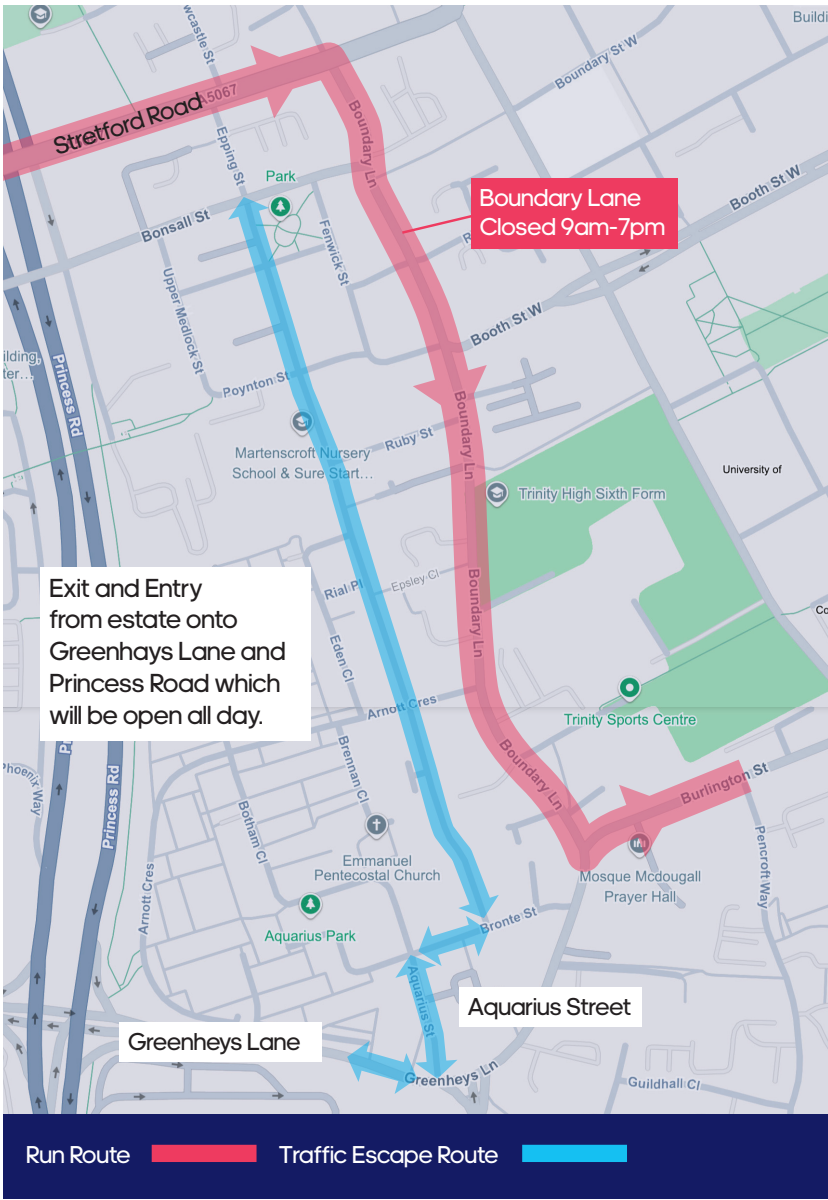
For residents in the Hulme Park area

Please see the below EXIT route available out of the area which avoids the closed Chorlton Road and Stretford Road. This will be via Reilly Street, onto Leaf Street, onto a barriered off lane of Stretford Road, from which you will need to turn left to get onto Princess Road.



For residents within the estate near Greenhays Lane

Please see the below route which can be used in both directions using Greenhays Lane and Princess Road. These roads are open throughout the day



For residents in the area North of Denmark Road and bounded by Lloyd St North and Oxford Rd

You will be able to leave the area heading west on Denmark Rd towards Princess Rd on the event closed roads during the following times: from when they close at 4:30am until 10:15am and then again from 5:50pm until 7pm. At 7pm Denmark Rd between Lloyd St North and Aberdeen St will re-open. At 8pm Denmark Rd between Aberdeen St and Oxford Rd and Oxford Rd between Hathersage Rd and Grafton Street will re-open. Oxford Rd North of Grafton Street will remain closed until 4am on Monday 20th April.
